 - Playing time for Highlanders is based on attendance, behavior and performance...
 - For U9-14 Highlander teams, players will receive a minimum of 50% playing time per game, should they meet the above standards. It is the responsibility of the coach to communicate to the player and/or parent of any circumstances, where a player falls below the standards set.
 - For U14-18, playing time is at the discretion of the coach.
