

OPTIMAL TECHNIQUE:

Ability to execute appropriate soccer actions within a game related setting

GENERAL EXPECTATIONS

• Commitment:

- Fall **AND** Spring (optional winter programs)
- Parent Volunteerism (Team manager / Referee / Assistant Coach)

Playing Time:

Minimum of 50% per game

Playing Positions:

- U8 U10:
 - Players will experience variety of positions throughout season.
- U11 U12:
 - Players may begin to narrow down positions in order to perform their role at a higher level

Sideline Behavior:

- Players play, Coaches teach, Referees officiate. Let them play

CONFLICT RESOLUTION

- Wait at least <u>24 hours</u> after a game before addressing any issue with a coach.
- Avoid parking lot or sideline talk with other parents:
 - They cannot resolve the issue!
- Bring issue to <u>coach</u> first.


